Judges 2:6-23 (in preparation for May 15<sup>th</sup> sermon)

**First Things First**

1. Pray for the Holy Spirit to open your heart to the Scriptures to shape your thinking, beliefs, and choices with God-honoring faith and obedience.
2. Read Judges 2:6-23 out loud together.
3. Have one or two people summarize the passage in their own words.
4. What are some important details that should not be overlooked in this passage? What themes or patterns help us identify what the author of Judges wants us to take note of?

**Renewing our Minds in the Truth**

5. What do we learn about God (His character and His ways) in this passage?
6. What do we learn about humanity in this passage?
7. How does Judges 2 point us to our need for the gospel?

**Taking the Word to Heart and Life**

8. How might your life change if you apply the principles represented in this passage?
9. What specific actions or attitudes can you implement this week in response to Judges 2? (Begin your answer with "I will...")
10. What change needs to take place in your heart in order to follow through faithfully on applying the teaching of this passage to your life this week? How do you need to pray for God to work in your heart to make that change possible?
11. How might your faithful response and application of this text impact the generations that follow you (children and grandchildren). How will they be affected if you don't give heed to Judges 2?

**Serving One Another from the Heart**

12. What challenge are you facing in life, family, or community that we can help you with (pray, encourage, serve)?
13. Pray for God to meet practical needs and concerns in each other's lives. Pray for God's grace to empower each other to live according to the truths we have learned from Judges 2.
